The Global Business Travel Association (GBTA) writes in support H.R. 4, the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018.

Business travel is an economic driver. Businesses send employees on 40 million business trips within the United States and around the world – most of which involve air travel. In fact, according to the most recent GBTA research, U.S. companies spent over \$47.4 billion on air travel in 2016, comprising 18 percent of total travel spending.
