

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5292
OFFERED BY MR. LIPINSKI OF ILLINOIS

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 3. REPORT ON TRAINING OUTCOMES OF AIR TRAFFIC**
2 **CONTROLLER HIRES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.— Not later than 90 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the
5 Federal Aviation Administration shall begin collecting
6 data on training and hiring outcomes with respect to air
7 traffic controllers that contains the following:

8 (1) The comparative cost of training military
9 veterans, general public hires, and graduates of a
10 Collegiate Training Initiative program maintained
11 pursuant to section 44506 of title 49, United States
12 Code.

13 (2) The total time from hire to earning Cer-
14 tified Professional Controller status of military vet-
15 erans, general population hires, and Collegiate
16 Training Initiative program graduates.

17 (3) The applicant to graduate ratio of military
18 veterans, general population hires, and Collegiate
19 Training Initiative program graduates.

1 (4) The placement of military veterans, general
2 population hires, and Collegiate Training Initiative
3 program graduates by facility type.

4 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the end
5 of each fiscal year, the Administrator shall submit to Con-
6 gress a report on the data collected under subsection (a)
7 for the preceding fiscal year. Such report shall include a
8 summary of trends for all previous years in which such
9 data has been collected.
